



Nelson Naturist Park (NNP) visitor arrivals: All persons entering the grounds do so at their own risk.

- Please make every effort to advise NNP club hosts / caretakers of your anticipated arrival time *(so they can arrange for you to be met when entering the grounds)*.
- Upon arrival you will be requested to sign-in on behalf of yourself and your guests. *(By signing in, your party will become temporary member/s of Nelson Naturist Park for the duration of your stay. This includes that you indemnify the club and/or its members from any/all claims and actions.)*

NNP Visitor bookings and payment:

- Payment for your booking is to be made upon arrival. *(Payment may be made by cash or online.)*
- Visitor stays may be extended if suitable accommodation is available and by arrangement with our club hosts / caretakers. In this case the additional payment is to be made at that time.
- Please be aware that while the club will try to accommodate your preferences, this may not always be possible and you may be offered an alternative campsite or room.

NNP Rules for members and visitors *(must be adhered to at all times):*

- **Injury:** The club and/or its members take no responsibility for the activities of persons, including children, when swimming, walking, hiking, playing golf, excessive sun exposure or indeed any other social or recreational activity around the club grounds.
- **Creek:** Please be aware the creek is not fenced therefore parents must be responsible for their own children when near the creek.
- **Behaviour:** Misbehaviour is not tolerated and Nelson Naturist Park reserves the right to terminate anyone's visit and/or accommodation. Persons whose behaviour is adversely affected by alcohol or drugs or demonstrates domestic or other violence, or lewd or sexually overt behaviour will not be tolerated. Offenders will be expelled from the property.
- **Speed Limit:** A speed limit of 10 km/hour applies to the entire property.
- **Right of Way:** Pedestrians *(including young children)* always have the right of way.
- **Children:** Parents are advised that children playing *(e.g., on the trampoline, riding bicycles or scooters)* do so at their own risk. Children under the age of 10 must be accompanied by an adult in the shower/ toilet block, laundry area, BBQ area, pool area and clubhouse.
- **Photography:** The taking of photographs of people is prohibited *(except by the club's authorised persons, who will ask permission first)*.
- **Fires:** No Fires *(except the BBQs, in the communal recreation area near the spa and pool and the club house wood-burner)*.
- **Pool area:** The pool and spa are both zoned full nudity / au naturel only. No clothing to be worn in the pool or spa, but light clothing *(e.g., t-shirts)* may be worn for the purpose of sun protection in the spa / pool area. No glass allowed in this area - use plastic cups or similar.
- **Smoking:** Smoking / vaping is permitted only in your own motorhome / caravan or on the mini-ten court.

- **Illegal drugs:** Illegal drugs are strictly prohibited anywhere on club property.
 - **Emergency Evacuation Plan:** All members and visitors are to meet on the open concrete near the pool and follow the fire marshal or police instructions. Do not leave the grounds before telling first, unless instructed to evacuate.
 - **Pets | Dogs:** To ensure the comfort, safety and enjoyment of all members, residents and visitors, the following rules apply to anyone wishing to bring a dog onto Club grounds.
General Policy: Pets and other animals are not permitted on Club grounds, except in the following circumstances: Dogs are permitted only in accordance with the rules outlined below and these rules apply to all Club members, guests and visitors.
1. **Pets belonging to Bach Occupiers** are permitted where provided for under Section 1.13 of their lease agreement.
 2. **Pets belonging to Visitors:** Visitors wishing to bring one or more dogs onto Club grounds must notify the Booking Officer or Camp Host before arrival.
 3. Visitors or members staying in the clubhouse are not permitted to bring dogs.
 4. A maximum of two dogs is permitted per campsite, bach or visiting party.
 5. Dogs are not permitted in any communal areas, including:
 - * The Happy Hour area
 - * The swimming pool area
 - * In or around the clubhouse
 - * The golf course
 6. Dogs may only be exercised along the entrance driveway or outside the Club grounds.
 7. Dog owners are responsible for ensuring their dogs:
 - * Are kept under control at all times.
 - * Remain quiet and do not cause a nuisance through excessive barking, whining or aggressive behaviour.
 - * Are always secured on a lead no longer than 3 metres. The lead must be attached to the caravan or motorhome—not to awning poles. Portable pet enclosures or fencing within an awning area are permitted.
 - * Have all waste collected immediately using dog waste bags. All dog waste must be removed from the Club grounds and disposed of off-site.
 - * Are properly cared for, with owners accepting full responsibility for their welfare, behaviour and any damage or inconvenience they may cause.
 - * Day Visitors bringing a dog must keep the dog secured to their vehicle while parked in the designated car park and must clean up after their dog before leaving the Club grounds.
 8. **Failure to Comply:** The privilege of bringing a dog onto Club grounds may be withdrawn at any time. Where any issues or breach of these rules arise, any two members of the Committee may revoke permission and the dog owner must immediately remove the dog or dogs from the Club grounds.
